ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

- Do I want to buy my own furniture?

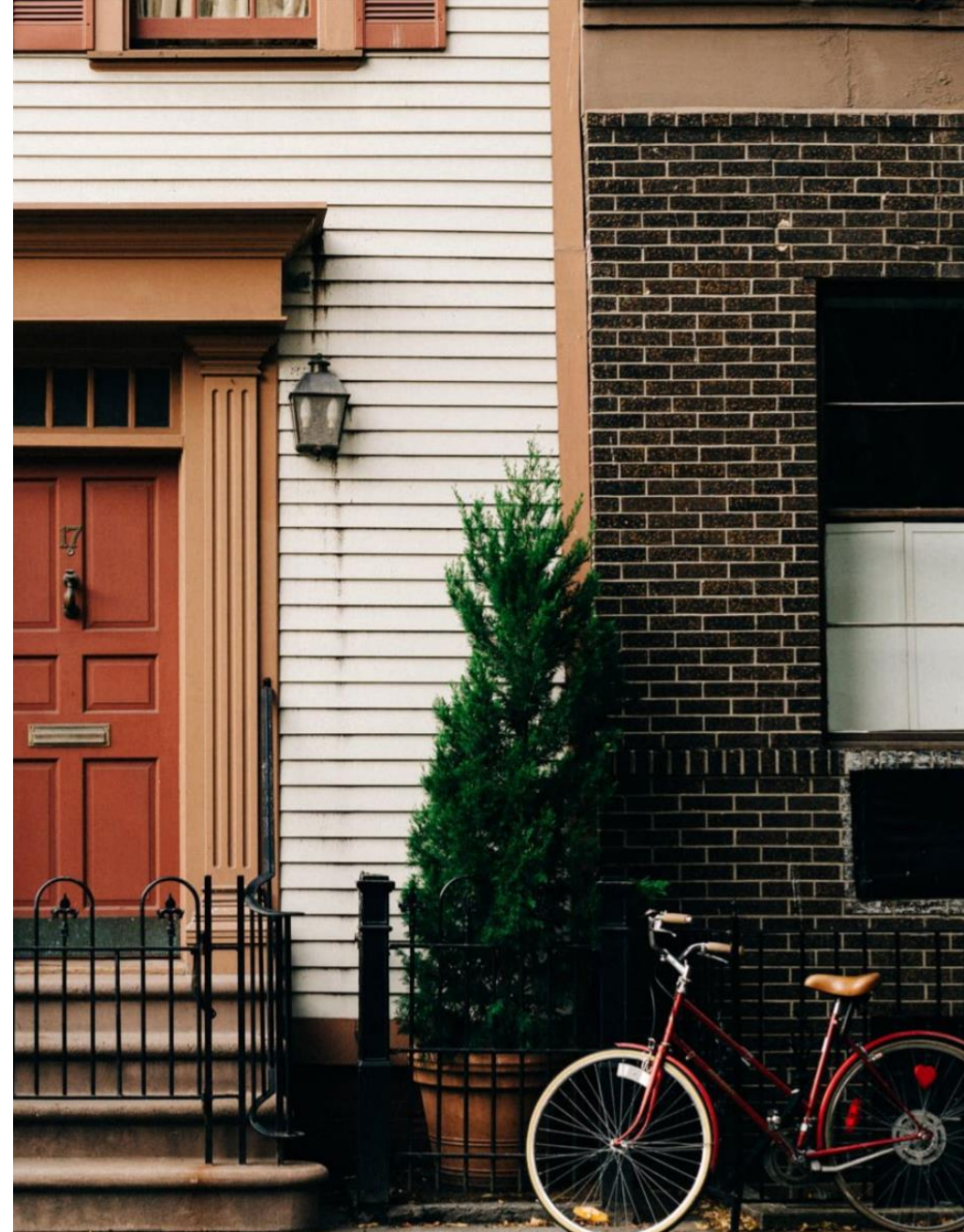

HOMESTAY

Homestay is a safe and affordable. Typically, you will have your own bedroom and two or three meals with the family per day. Living or boarding in a home with a local family can be a great way to know more about daily Australian life and improve your English skills.
